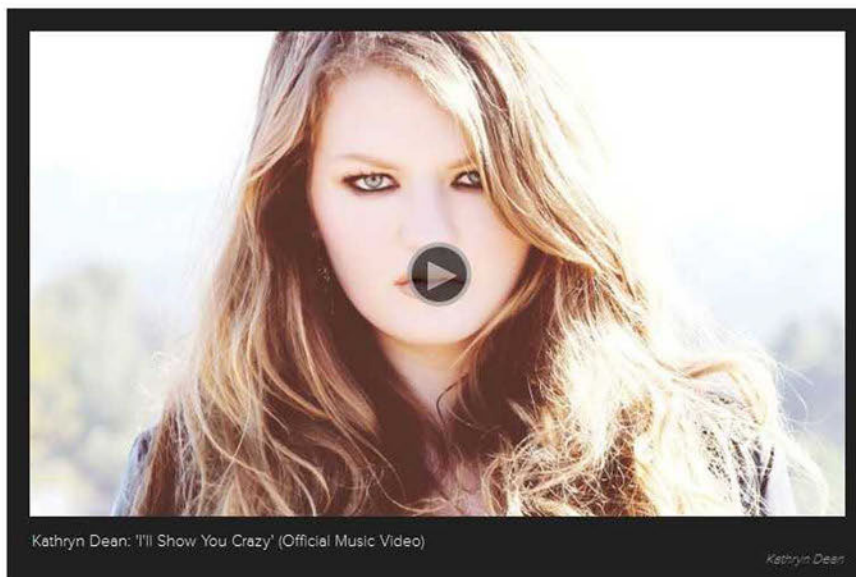

Since [we introduced you](#) to singer Kathryn Dean in September, there's been a lot going on with the teenage singer. She's just released the [music video](#) for her song "I'll Show You Crazy" and has a few big new shows on the horizon. We checked back in with Kathryn last week to talk about everything that's happened since the release of her EP last fall.

She called the drop of that self-titled record "a very surreal experience. It's almost like putting your child out into the world...You put all the time and energy and love into it, and then it gets to a point where you kind of have to let it go."

Another quirk? While [music fans](#) might be just getting introduced to Kathryn, she's already hard at work on new music, which makes getting feedback on the EP a little bit like *deja vu*. "Since I wrote the songs myself, they're not as new to me as they are for my listeners," she explained. "To me, it's not even new. I'm always excited about the most recent new songs."



"Right now I'm in the studio," she continued, "and we're working on a full-length album, which we want to release in the beginning of 2015. I'm looking forward to that."

While she's been writing the next batch of material, Kathryn took time out to shoot her first music video for the single "I'll Show You Crazy," which has already racked up some seven thousand hits online. "[It] was made with the most amazing director to walk the face of this earth, Paul Boyd," she enthused, praising "his vision in terms of the story," which jazzes up the typical assertive-woman theme with some truly colorful characters and unique locations.

But she's not just relying on other people to keep her success going. A diligent developer of her own brand, she's also worked on building her social media following, and can be found playing select shows in the Los Angeles area. You can see Kathryn perform live at a pair of great venues later this month: on November 23 at The Mint in Los Angeles and November 29 at Sainte Roche in Hermosa Beach.

She's even gone international. "We have an amazing publishing company, and they've been really pushing my music," she revealed. "I got onto a popular TV show in Brazil called *Malhacao*; a couple of my songs ["So Undeniable" and "Told You So"] were placed in the show. So now my EP is out there."

All these happenings over just a few months might be a lot for someone who can't even drink yet, but this humble and high-energy performer insists that everything that's developed since September hasn't changed who she is. She's still very much like any other eighteen-year-old. "I'm a happy camper," Kathryn told us, "Filling my free time with my one true love, aside from Netflix and froyo."
